- 1997 – Robert Segel forms Tucker Anthony Private Equity (TAPE) as a joint venture with Tucker Anthony to provide private equity partnership investment services to third-party investors
- 1998 – \$113.0M, TAPE
 - Dorr Begnal joins Park Street Capital
- 1999 – \$165.0M, TAPE II
- 2000 – Heather Foley joins Park Street Capital
- 2001 – \$300.0M, TAPE III
 - \$42.8M, TAPE Tech
 - Concurrent with Royal Bank of Canada's acquisition of Tucker Anthony, TAPE becomes fully independent and changes name to Park Street Capital
 - Kristine Dailey joins Park Street Capital
- 2002 – \$206.6M, TAPE IV
 - Timothy Lyle joins Park Street Capital
 - Ken Smith joins Park Street Capital
